Remote Learning

If your child is unable to attend school because of A) a positive Covid test B) because they are self-isolating because of Covid symptoms or C) an enforced Covid related reason - we will provide work for them that is in line with the curriculum we are following at school.

The teacher will contact you within 24 hours of notification that they are self-isolating and discuss the best way that we can provide work. Our preferred method is to set the work using Microsoft TEAMS, if your child has access to the internet to complete the work.
