## **Changes**

As detailed in my communication earlier this week, we are able to make some changes from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May that will move us back towards some of our normal arrangements.

### Start of day

The school day will start for everyone at **8:55am**. Arrival after this time will need to be signed in late at the school office. Children can arrive from **8:45am** but must go straight to their classrooms, where their class teacher will be waiting.

### End of day

The school day will end for everyone at **3:20pm**. Please maintain distancing measures as you wait for your child and leave the school site immediately once they are with you.

### Nursery

Morning Nursery will continue to operate between **9:00am** and **12:00**.

We have been very flexible with timings to support families through and after lockdown. However, our children need to get back into their normal routine so we really appreciate your support in being ready to be on time.

### Uniform

Children should come to school each day in their normal school uniform. PE kit can be left at school in a PE bag on your child's peg. We will send this home each Friday for you to wash. Forest school clothing can be brought in a bag on the day for your child to get changed into and will be sent home on the same day.

### Volunteers

We are starting by inviting people who have been previous volunteers in school to return, should they wish to. Please contact school to arrange a meeting if this applies to you.

### Before & After School Club

This will return to Wheatley House, at the top of the playground. Children who attend should be dropped off and collected from there.

### Clubs

We are cautiously starting some clubs, but need to keep bubbles of children together. Staff will send communications about what is on offer.

### Educational Visits

Staff are currently planning a calendar of visits to start from September.
