The children will identify when and why these are used and use them appropriately in their own writing.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Animals including humans.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The human life cycle as these main stages – foetus, new-born, infancy, childhood, adolescence, adulthood. • A foetus is an unborn animal or human being in the very early stages of development. • The gestation period is how long it takes the foetus to develop. • Adolescence is also known as puberty. • Changes take place in puberty including growth in height, development of underarm hair, increase in sweat and growth of • body parts such as male genitals and female breasts. • As you get older you get wrinkles because your skin becomes thinner and less elastic.
