The children will be writing, editing and redrafting a poem based on this text.</i></p> <p><i><u>Beetle Boy</u></i></p> <p><i>We will be doing a unit of work based on the incredible and complex characters and strange plot of this story. There are links with PSHE units within this amazing story.</i></p> <p>SPAG: We will be focussing on modal verbs, cohesion and punctuation. The children will identify what they are, when and why these are used and use them appropriately in their own writing.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Forces</u></p> <p>We will be investigating this area of Science this half term and planning practical activities to support our learning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify the effect of drag forces, such as air resistance, water resistance and friction that act between moving surfaces. • Understand that some mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect. • Carry out fair tests to show how streamlined objects travel quicker and why.

We will discover facts and surprises about their civilisation and make links to see how their way of life has affected society.
